NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Buoyancy vests or impact vests shall be worn.
- 1.3 Racing rule 26 will be changed as follows: The class warning flag for each class shall be displayed three minutes before that classes start. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at middle floor of the Takapuna Boating Club.

2 ADVERTISING

Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows: Competitors shall not carry advertising that conflicts with event or club sponsors.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the foiling and skiff class(es). Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.takapunaboating.org.nz
- 3.2 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority.
- 3.3 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Entries are restricted to 50 competitors.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1** Date of racing: Sunday 11th October
- 5.2** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first class is 12.57pm

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 17.00 on Friday 9th October on the Takapuna Boating Club website and on the notice board in the clubhouse.

7 VENUE

- 7.1** Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 7.2** Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1** The courses to be sailed will be as follows: One long distance race of between one and two hours duration. The exact course will be decided by 20.00 hours on the day before the race.
- 8.2** For the all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 8.3** Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

9 SCORING

The scoring system is as follows: Competitors will be ranked in the order they finish.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters. Spot prizes will also be given.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for

material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
