NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the middle floor of the Takapuna Boating Club.
- 1.4 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the middle floor of the Takapuna Boating Club and online at www.takapunaboating.org.nz

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 420 class.

- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter online at www.takapunaboating.org.nz by 11 January 2021.
- 3.3** Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority on payment of a late entry fee of \$100.00.
- 3.4** To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority.
Proof of affiliated club membership to be submitted at registration.
- 3.5** Each competitor, entrant and crew members shall be financial members of the NZ 420 Class association.

- 5.2** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 11.00
- 5.3** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15.00.

6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1** Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate on request.
- 6.2** A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 at all times.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 17.00 on 5th February 2021 at the middle floor of the Takapuna Boating Club and online at www.takapunaboating.org.nz

8 VENUE

- 8.1** Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 8.2** Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward/Leeward or Trapezoid.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1** For the 420 class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

- 11.1** 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2**
 - a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - b) When five to nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

13 PRIZES

Prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority and class association.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent. Certificate of insurance is to be presented on request.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
