NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 For Windsurfing classes, Appendix B shall apply.
- 1.4 For Kitesurfing classes, Appendix F shall apply.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the middle floor of Takapuna Boating Club and www.takapunaboating.org.nz
- 1.6 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows:
Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of foiling and skiff classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form on www.takapunaboatingclub.org.nz

4 FEES

Required fees are as follows:

All classes	FEE
Series	TBC members: Free, Non-members: \$100
Day	TBC members: Free, Non-members: \$15

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Dates of racing: Every Thursday from 8th October until 10th December 2020.
- 5.2 Number of races: Up to five races will be sailed each day.

- 5.3 The first warning signal will be at 18.15
- 5.4 On scheduled race days no warning signal will be made after 30 minutes before sunset.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 17.00 hours on 6th October at the middle floor of Takapuna Boating club or online www.takapunaboating.org.nz

7 VENUE

- 7.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 7.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

- 8.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Windward/Leeward or as advised in the sailing instructions.
- 8.2 For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

10 SCORING

Each day's races will be scored to determine the daily ranking. Daily rankings will then be combined with each competitor's best seven out of ten daily rankings counting towards their final series score.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
For fleets of 8 or more: 1st place \$300, 2nd place \$200, 3rd place \$100
Prizes will also be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd Women in each fleet.
Prizes may also be given to place getters in fleets of seven or fewer at the discretion of the organising authority.
Daily spot prizes will be given at the conclusion of racing.
- 11.2 To be eligible for prizes, a valid entry form must have been submitted by 5pm on 8th October 2020
- 11.3 Series prizegiving will be following the conclusion of racing on Thursday 10th December.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
